# Democracy in the ancient Athens

- ▶ By the 5th century B.C. , several democratic systems have been established in several polises of ancient Hellas.
- ▶ This differs from the liberal democracy that we have today, but it is still seen as the origin.
- ▶ The most well-known of the ancient polis democracies is Athens.





# How does democracy work?

- ▶ The relationship between the individual and the community is mutual (but sometimes it is only apparent).
- ▶ The relationship between these two has changed a lot since then.
