When we first met the conce Democracy

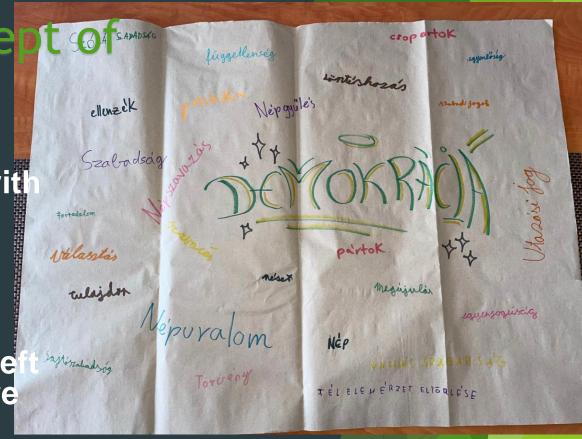
Our teacher decided to play a game with us. We had to think of four words that came to our mind about democracy.
